A couple reminders for parents:

If you would like to schedule a conference with your child's teacher please let them know and a time can be set up.

Please make sure you are checking the dates on your child's car seat as most manufacturers put a limit of 6 years on their car seats, but not all. The best place to find this information is inside the instruction manual that came with your car seat. If you can't find the information (or the instruction manual) call the manufacturer and find out. And don't forget to ask for another manual, most companies provide them for free.

Once you know the life span of your car seat you need to check out the seat. On the car seat you will find a sticker or label with the make and model of your car seat along with the date of manufacture. Car seats expire from their date of manufacture, **not** the date you received the seat or first installed it in your car.
